RULES & REGULATIONS FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

(* Amended by Academic Council & BOM as per UGC Regulation 2016)

General Guidelines for Foreign Students seeking admission to Ph.D.

- 1. Eligibility Criteria for Admission:** A candidate seeking admission to the Programme for Degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) must have obtained a Masters Degree or a degree recognized by the University of Technology as equivalent to its master's degree in the subject in which the candidate wishes to pursue a course of research, or in a subject allied thereto as per UGC eligibility criteria and Proof of English proficiency (A certificate or marksheet indicating that the undergraduate/Post graduate courses are taken in English or IELTS/TOEFL Academic score of 5.0/60 and above or equivalent).
- 2. Admission to Ph.D. Programme:** The candidate shall apply for admission to Ph.D. programme on a prescribed form, which may be downloaded/ filled online at the University of Technology website <http://uot.edu.in>. The application for admission shall be submitted to the admission office, University of Technology. In case of documents/testimonials in a language other than English, the same must be translated into English and attested copies of the same need to be attached with the application. The candidates are advised to consult research department and/or to check specialization visit university website to pursue their Ph.D.
- 3.** The foreign students who wish to enroll themselves in PhD program are required to be Post Graduate/Masters or possessing any equivalent degree in the relevant subject with 55% of marks from an institution recognized/listed by the UGC/AIU for such purpose. In case the University/Board is not included in the AIU list, the foreign student has to obtain and submit Equivalence Certificate to this effect from the Association of Indian Universities.
- 4.** In lieu of the entrance test, it would be mandatory for all foreign students from non-English speaking countries to pass the English Proficiency Course conducted by the School of Humanities & Social Sciences, University of Technology, Jaipur. Their enrolment to Ph.D. would be subject to satisfactory completion of the Proficiency course. This course is a blended learning course that is made up of some classroom teaching and some online component. Students can attend it for 6 months. The fee is Rs 10000/- per Semester.
- 5.** The International students who are not present in the University of Technology Ph.D. Entrance test will need to achieve at least band 5 in IELTS Academic or 60 in TOEFL or 150-154 in GRE or 600 in GMAT. At the time of filling the enrolment form the candidate must attach of the score in any one of the above tests, however, all such candidates will have to qualify in the interview. The interview for admission will be held through online/offline mode, as the case may be.

6. **Fees:** As decided and notified by the University from time to time.
7. **Visa:** Candidates selected for Ph.D. admission shall be issued provisional admission letters, with a copy to the embassy concerned, to facilitate their visa process. The enrolment would be finally based only on production of valid Study/Research Visa. In case the student fails to do so, the university reserves the right to cancel admission. The President/Vice Chancellor can condone any delay in submitting or procuring visa or other documents required for continuing admission.
8. **Course Work:** All foreign students admitted to the Ph.D. Programme shall have to complete the course work offered by the concerned Department satisfactorily as per University of Technology rules. They will have to join the course work in the semester that follows the completion of their admission formalities.
9. After completion of Pre-Ph.D. Course Work it will be mandatory for International Students to present him/her-self before the DRC/RAC for registration physically with original documents as required.
10. Submission of semester progress report and further presentation may be done online or offline as per University rules and regulations.
11. Thesis Submission.
 - (a) In order to become eligible for the submission of the pre submission Seminar, the candidate must have at least two publications in SCI journals/UGC care /referred Journals.
 - (b) International students have to present his/her pre-submission seminar as per university norms.
 - (c) Rest of the rules for synopsis, thesis submission/viva-voce will be as per the Rules and Regulations of the University.
12. Other rules and regulations of University of Technology will apply to foreign students as well.
13. Admission Schedule: As per University of Technology, Jaipur Rules.
14. The final authority for interpreting the rules and guidelines given herein, or condonement of any nature, would rest with the President/Vice Chancellor.
15. In any dispute relating to any affairs relating to it will be subjected to the jurisdiction of the court Jaipur (Rajasthan).
